Respected passengers:

With best wishes to you, Imam Khomeini International Airport Customs has prepared and published this brochure in order to be aware of the customs regulations of the passenger's goods and to inform our dear compatriots. By studying it carefully, we will be able to achieve our goals, which are to provide better service, to satisfy passengers and to fulfill our legal assigned duties.

A: Regulations of arrival passengers:

- Every passenger entering the country can bring in foreign goods in addition to her/his personal belongings provided that there is no legal and religious prohibition and also respecting its non-commercial aspect. The entry of foreign goods with the passenger is subject to the entry fee, but the entry fee for each passenger is exempt from the payment of the entry fee up to the maximum value of 80 \$ per year and the extra goods are subject to the entry fee. The exemption is used once a year and does not include heavy goods such as refrigerators, TVs and...

Note: The items listed must be in the form of gifts, souvenirs or personal items to include the conditions of the passenger's carry-on goods. In simpler terms, the goods must not be for sale, otherwise they will be excluded from the passenger rules and subject to commercial rules.

- The passenger who entering the country must declare the goods with him/her to Customs and refrain from hiding and embedding them, otherwise he/she will be subject to the smuggling laws.
- According to the central bank's circular, there is no restriction on the entry of currency and bank documents and unnamed securities up to a ceiling of 10 thousand Euros or its equivalent into other currencies and does not require a currency declaration, but more than that requires a declaration to Customs and the observance of customs protocols.

- The enter of jewelry made of gold, silver and platinum with the passenger such as necklaces, bracelets, earrings; ring, bangles and... for personal use as a unit (one of each and one pair of earrings and six bangles) in total amount up to 150 grams will be allowed, and more than that, a license from the Central Bank is required.
- Entry of medicines and any dietary supplements requires legal permits such as the Ministry of Health, etc., in addition to entry fees or commercial protocols.
- Cigarette entry is allowed per passenger at the rate of one box equivalent to 200 cigarettes or 50 Cuban cigarettes. The allowable amount of tobacco per passenger is 250 grams.
- The entry of dogs and cats are prohibited by law, and domestic and non-domestic animals and birds are subject to the provision of a health certificate from the country of origin and the approval of the veterinary agency, taking into account the legal regulations of the country. (Animal quarantine).
- The entry of wild animals, birds and etc., will be subject to the presentation of certificates from organizations related to the country of origin, health certificates and approvals of the Environmental Protection Agency of Iran.
- According to article 122 of the customs code, the entry of drones, including helicopters and quadcopters and ... is subject to legal permission and if people carry this vehicle when leaving the country, they must declare the status to customs.
- The costs incurred by the air transport company from passengers for overloading, have nothing to do with customs duties and these companies have a weight exemption of up to 20-25 and 30 kg according to their conditions.

Customs regulations for departure passengers

- It is allowed to carry personal jewelry up to 150 grams per passenger from all kinds of gold, silver and platinum artefacts.
- Passengers are allowed to carry silver containers and artefacts (except jewelry) up to 3 kilograms, provided that these containers are not considered historical and cultural artifacts.
- Foreign currency, bank documents and nameless securities are allowed to carry for each passenger up to a total of 5 thousand Euros or its equivalent in other currencies, and the extra amount must be declared to the customs and follow the relevant protocols. Also, up to 5 million tomans is allowed.
- It is allowed to carry caviar up to 125 grams per passenger with a fishery license.
- It is allowed to carry saffron up to 150 grams per passenger.
- It is allowed to carry hand-woven carpets up to 24 square meters. (The countries of Iraq, Saudi Arabia and Syria are prohibited).
- It is forbidden to take any gold coins out of the country.
- It is allowed to export Iranian goods in any amount provided that it does not have a commercial aspect (The goods must not be for sale.).
- Since, according to the law, taking out of goods for repair or completion is subject to customs protocols, therefore, before leaving the country, the status must be declared to the customs.
- Carry professional tools and equipment with the passenger on the intention of returning the goods is subject to prior declaration and approval by the customs. To facilitate the return of professional instruments and equipment (audio, music, camera and..), the specifications and serial number of the goods shall be declared to customs so as not to be subject to the entry of foreign goods upon return to the country.

Prohibited goods:

- Alcoholic drinks
- Gambling items
- Cold weapons, firearms, incendiary and explosive materials
- Narcotics
- Publications, pictures, films, photographs and any goods that are contrary to the religious and national affairs of the country
- Any type of writing against the official religion of the country or disrupting public peace and decency and national affairs
- Antique items and all goods that have the aspect of cultural heritage
- And other goods that are forbidden by law

Registration of the passenger's mobile phone:

- Each incoming passenger is allowed to enter a new mobile device in addition to her/his used phone, and passengers must declare their mobile phone to customs when entering (The import of Apple's iPhone 14 and higher models to the country are prohibited).

Up to 30 days from the date of entry to the country, passengers should proceed to the procedure and activation of their phone.

List of prohibited pharmaceutical goods when traveling to Central Asian countries:

The entry of the following medicines during travel to Central Asian countries is prohibited by the customs of these countries and subject to heavy fines, so passengers are asked to refrain from carrying such medicines during travel to Central Asian countries even for personal use.

- * Acetaminophen codeine
- * Chlorodiazepoxide
- * Diphen oxyalt
- * Clonazepam
- * Coldax
- * Benscale
- * Sudafed
- * Coldstop
- * T_dol 100
- * Rai_dol 100
- * Afrin
- * Sudakal

Recommendations:

- Avoid receiving other people's goods because any legal responsibility is yours and if any customs violations are discovered, you must be held accountable.
- Travel as lightly as possible to reduce the delivery time and allow customs clearance to be completed in the shortest possible time.
- Avoid buying foreign goods to protect domestic industries and production and reduce unemployment.
- Avoid buying heavy and high-value goods such as television and...., it is better to buy such goods from within the country in order to avoid shipping costs and entry fees, which have warranty and after-sales service, consider that you only have an exemption of 80 \$.

- Carefully read the statements submitted by Customs and choose green or red routes according to their contents.

- When you leave the country, if you are sick and have medicine with you, you must have a prescription because the laws of countries are different and it is a crime to have some medicine in those countries.

- Remember, industrial and technical components , raw materials for factories and manufacturing and research units , medical centers and passengers cannot be cleared.

- Medicine , cosmetics , clothing ,shoes and accessories , gold jewelry and so on... In addition to not being cleared, even in the commercial stage, they also require the licenses of the Ministry of Commerce, Health, Communications and information technology, standards and ...
